TASTING NOTES

Widely believed to have originated in the northern Rhone region of France, Roussanne is well suited to California climate and topography. Our Roussanne is grown in the Dry Creek Valley of Northern Sonoma County. The long reliably dry growing season creates perfect conditions for late ripening this varietal to thrive. On the nose, this wine offers fresh aromas of fresh pear, nectarine, citrus blossom, and notes of baking spice. On the palate, layers of dried apricot, mango, and Meyer lemon zest are accented by hints of minerality.

SUGGESTED FOOD PAIRING

Due to the natural acidity and heavier body, this wine is excellent with dishes like bacon wrapped scallops and has a natural affinity for foie gras and pate. The flavor profile and crisp mouthfeel will nicely complement the flavors of fire grilled vegetables or fruits. A match for anything you might pair with Chardonnay, our 2023 Roussanne can also stand up to spicy fare.
